



CONVEYING RIGHT-OF-WAY TO CHRISTIAN COUNTY FOR MAINTENANCE

(PRIVATE TO PUBLIC)

Conveying right-of-way to the County is outlined in RSMo 228.190. Below is a quick summary of the items required by Statute and the County.

- Obtaining surveys and legal descriptions, as necessary
- Providing adequate right-of-way that meets current County standards (50 feet)
- Drafting right-of-way deeds, if required
- Ensuring that the roadways, cul-de-sacs, driveway connections, mailboxes, ditches, vegetation, culverts & signage all meet current County Standards
 - Improvements must be inspected at each interval by Highway Department staff
- Application be made to the County
- Commission meeting, Commission approval & recorded in minutes
- Approved/recorded by County Recorder
