Shall Chadwick R-I School District issue its general obligation bonds in the amount of \$2,000,000, estimated to result in no increase to the District's debt service property tax levy, for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, improving, repairing, renovating, furnishing and equipping school sites and facilities, including safety and security improvements throughout the District, renovating and improving the elementary school, upgrading the elementary school playground, purchasing school buses and acquiring property currently leased by the District and refinancing leasehold obligations?

If this question is approved, the District's debt service property tax levy is estimated to remain unchanged at \$1.0050 per \$100 dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
